

Pattern must be *reversed* to create fusible templates.

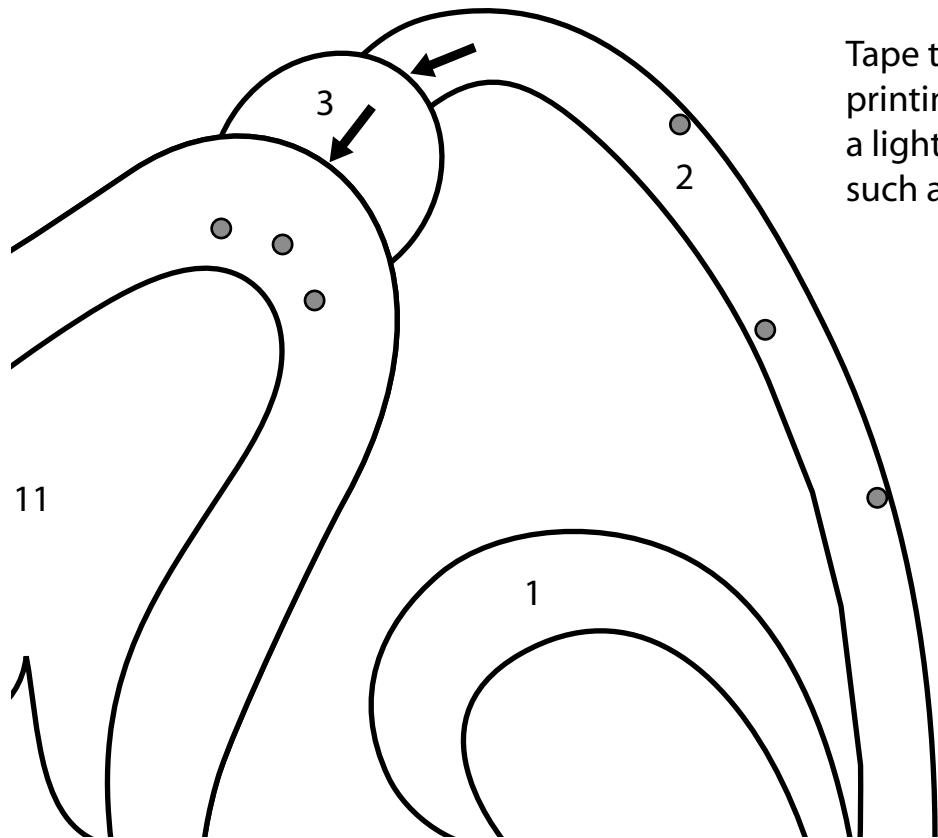
Shapes are numbered so the smallest number is fused to the background first.

Small arrows indicate which shape lies under another shape. Add a 1/8 inch extension to the bottom shape so it can be overlapped with the top shape.

Very small gray circles indicate possible placement of hot fix crystals.

Gray lines indicate some decorative stitching.

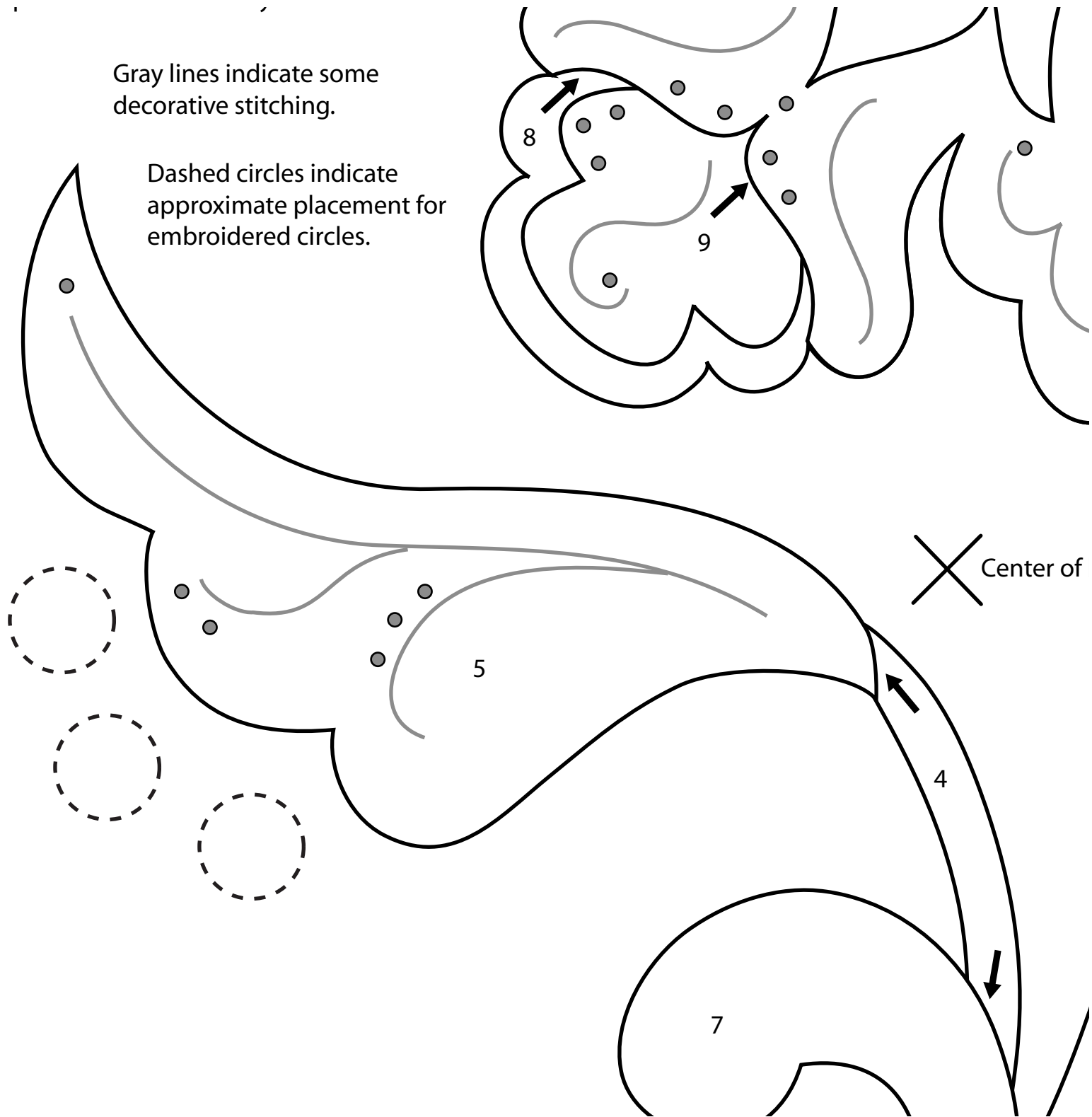


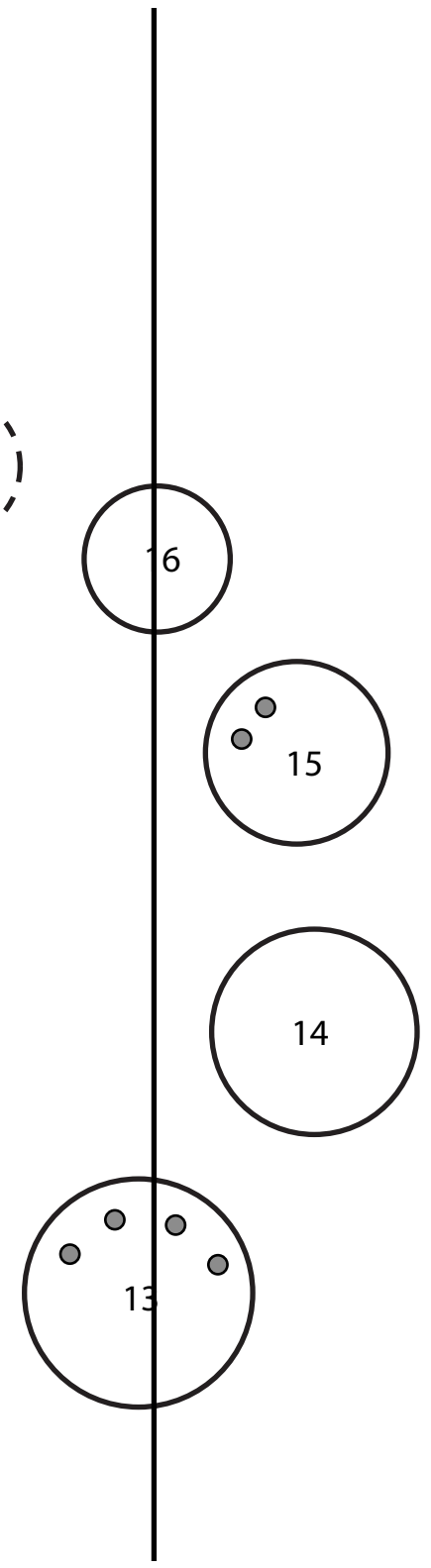
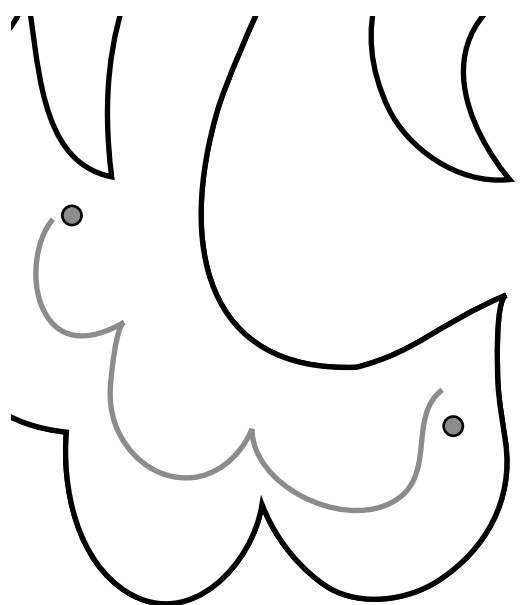
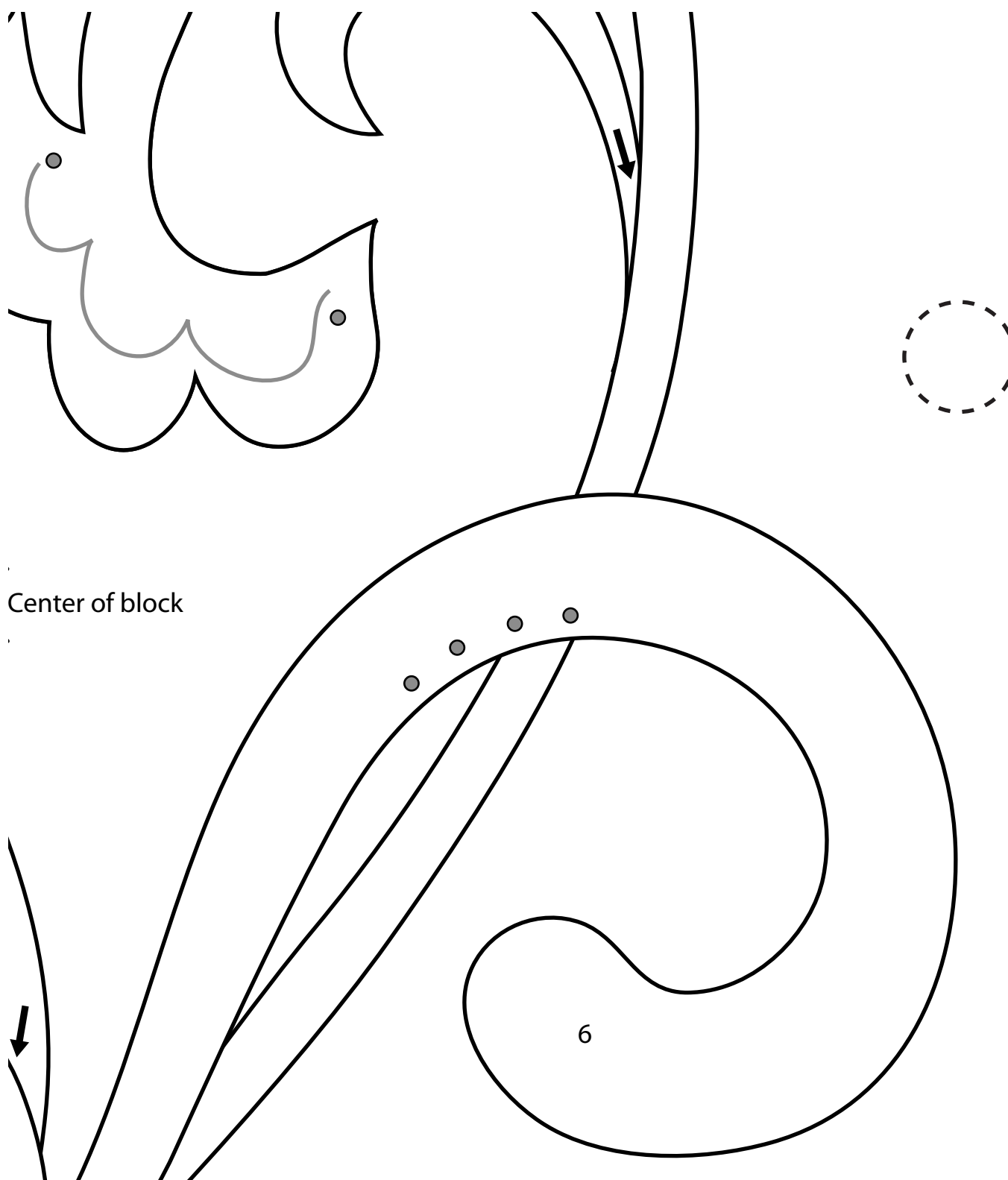


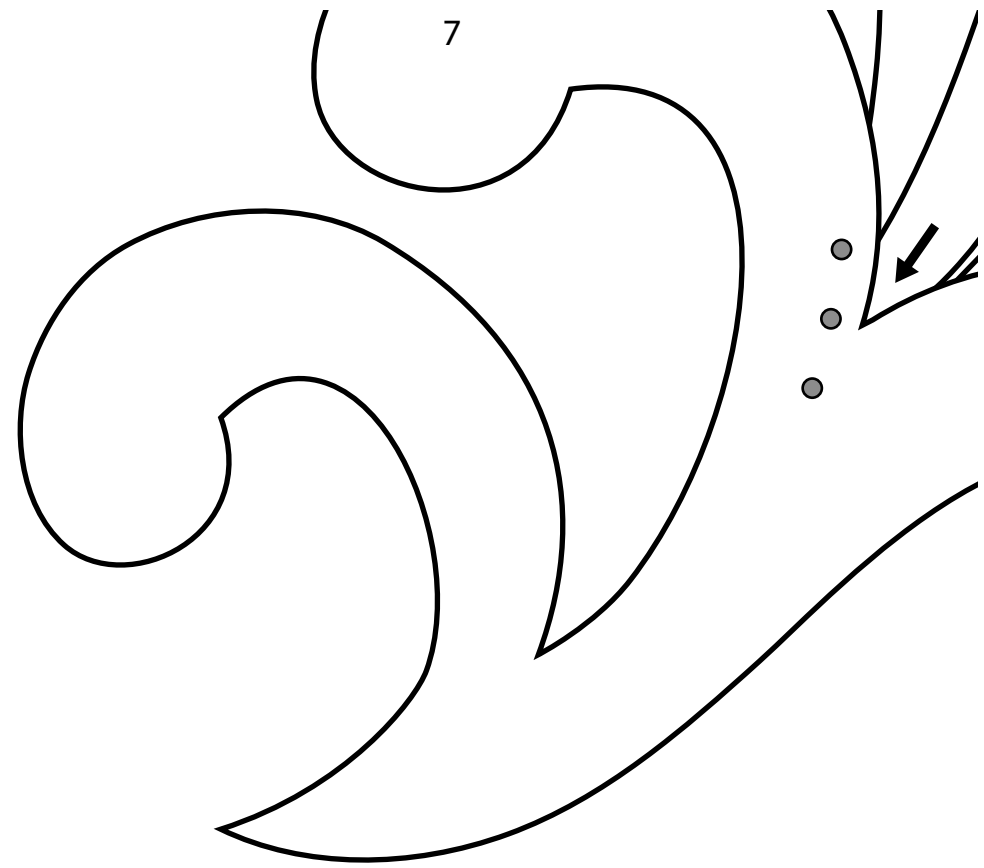
Tape the pattern together after printing. It is helpful to line it up on a light box or another light source such as a window.

Gray lines indicate some decorative stitching.

Dashed circles indicate approximate placement for embroidered circles.

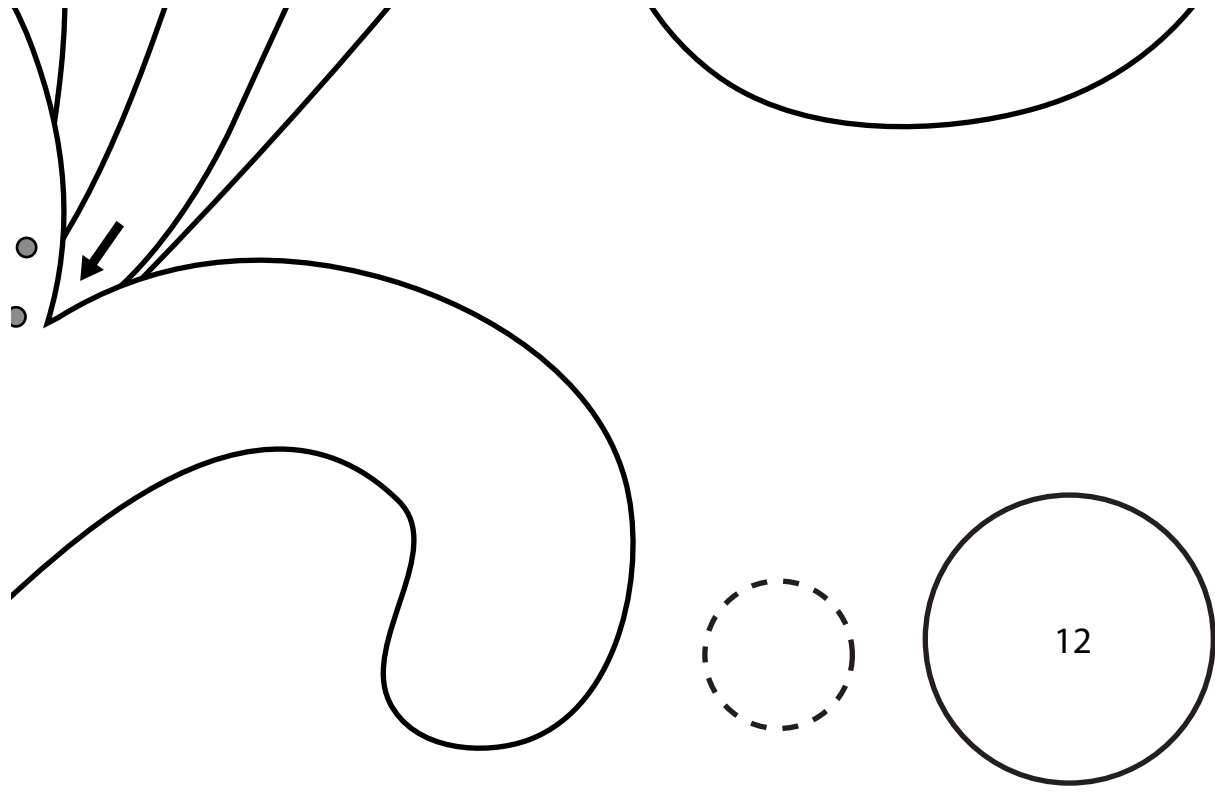
