**Skill Level:** Intermediate to Advanced

**Time:** 1-3 days (depending on skill level)

**Supplies Needed:**

- Janome Horizon Memory Craft 15000
- AcuFeed Flex Foot AD
- AcuFeed Flex Foot OD 1/4"
- Needle size 11 Blue Tip Needle
- 1110DX Pro serger (optional)

**Fabric and Notions:**

- Yardage as indicated on package
- Thread to match fabrics
- Buttons (covered if desired)



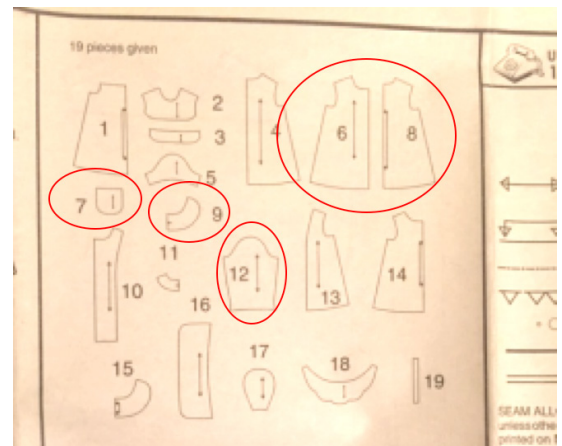
# Child's Fleece Coat

## Instructions:

### Optional Modifications:

#### 1. Cut the following pattern pieces:

- Coat Front #6
- Coat Pocket #7
- Coat Back #8
- Coat Collar #9
- Coat Sleeve #12
- Bonnet Crown #16
- Bonnet Back #17
- Bonnet Brim #18



#### 2. Following the pattern instructions, make the coat without the facings or lining. (The front, back, sleeves and pocket.)

\*Note: The collar is added at the end.

#### 3. Make the coat again so you will have two and then it will be self-lined.

#### 4. Sew the two coats together with the collar sandwiched in between.

#### 5. The cuffs can be made from contrasting fabric if desired.

\* For the bonnet, make two but omit the elastic and just make a tie. Sew them together to make it self-lined, inserting the tie where indicated for the elastic.
